



Magnolia Plantation and Gardens Youth Programs

Gardens Only - \$12 per student

Students are granted basic admission to Magnolia Plantation and gardens and the Audubon Swamp. No guided tours are included in this price. This program is best for pre-school -2nd grade.

****Nature and History-\$18 per student (Our Most Popular)***

Students will receive a 45-minute narrated tour that will include a tram ride around the outside of the historic gardens, giving insight to how Magnolia was created and has evolved since then. Students will also take part in the Slavery to Freedom tour which focuses on the lives of the enslaved and their contributions to the plantation. This program is best for 5th-College.

Full Youth Program - \$15 per student

This program is designed for students, 3rd - 8th grade. The program is approximately two hours long and consists of three rotational learning centers.

This will include Garden Admission cost and your choice of any combination of tours. All tours are approximately 45 mins long. (Nature Train, Nature Boat, Slavery to Freedom, Plantation House and the Audubon Swamp)

All Youth Programs include our Orientation Theatre, a 22 min film on the history of Magnolia, the Zoo & Nature Center, which features a collection of domestic and wild animals, The Conservator, Wildlife Observation Tower and the Horticultural Maze.

One chaperone per 6th child will receive complimentary admission and tour. Additional adult garden admission is 10.00 per adult and 6.00 per tour. Please be advised that only parents and/or chaperones who arrive on the bus will be allowed to go on the tours with students. Any parent or guardian arriving on their own are not guaranteed a place and must pay full garden admission.
